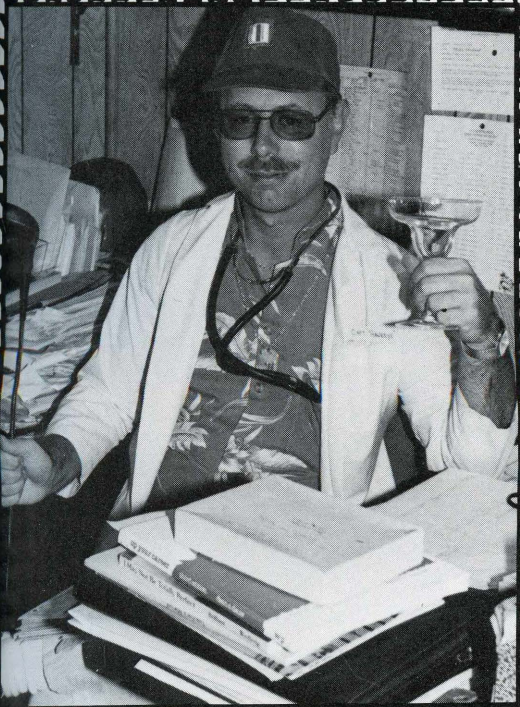
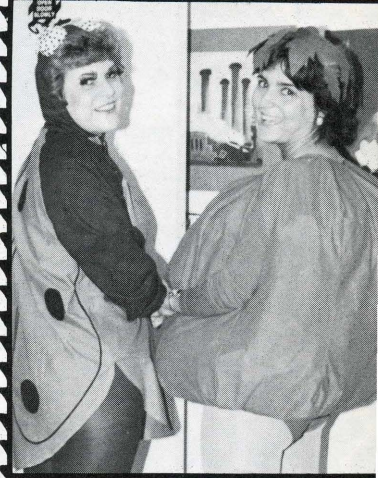
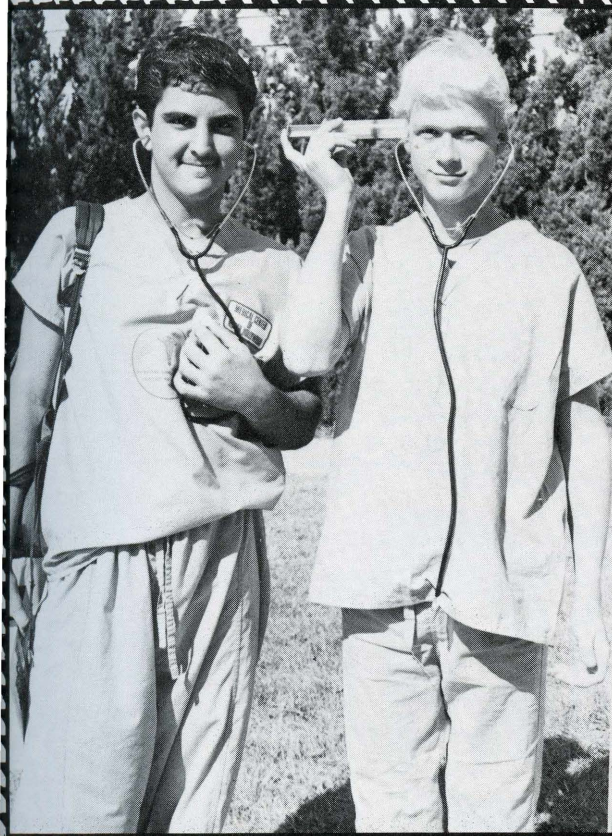


# Halloweenies

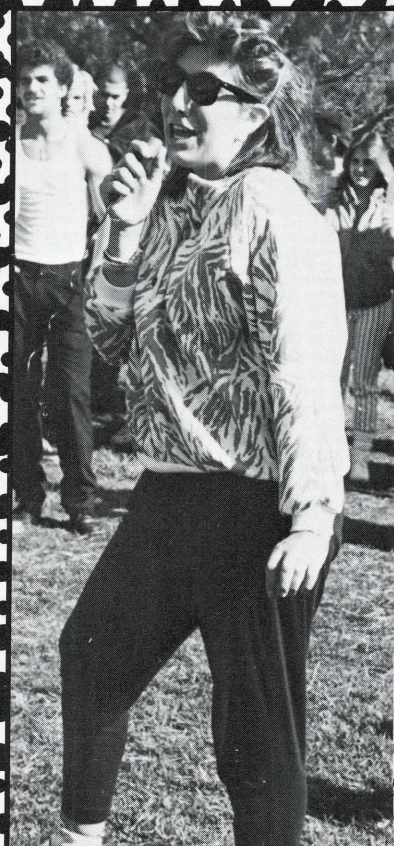




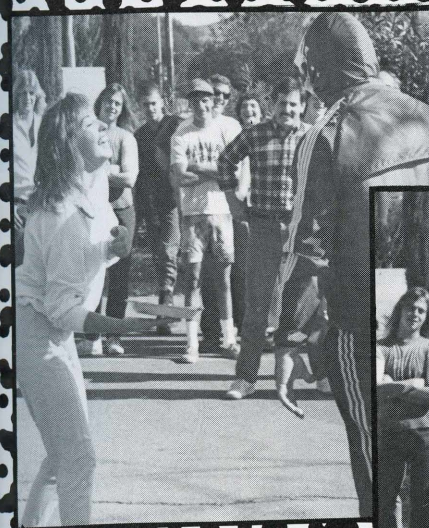
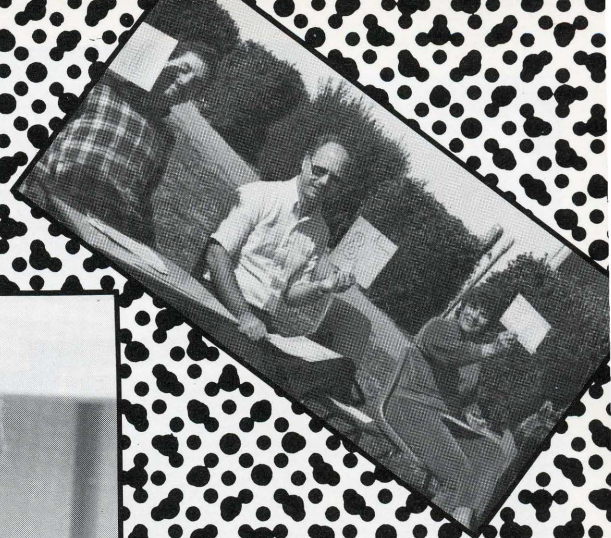
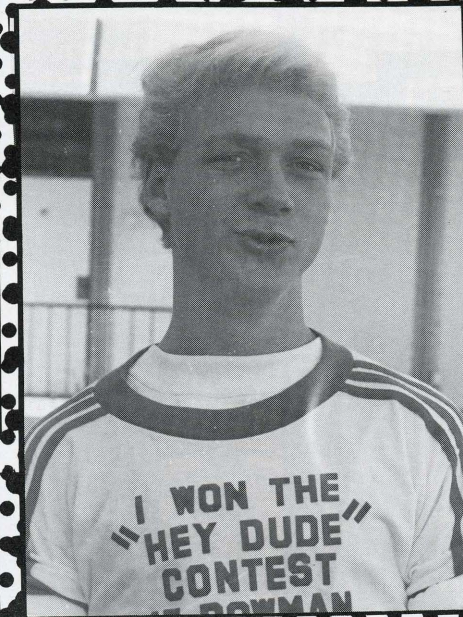


## Wahooo! Ya!

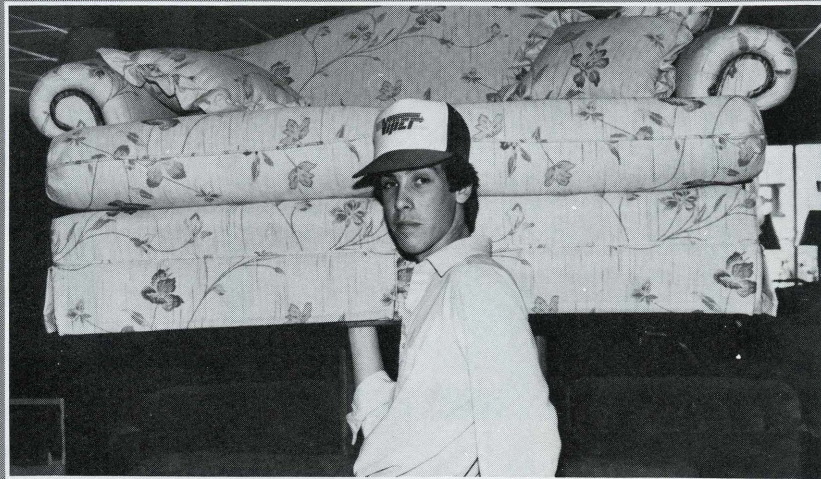
# Work Experience
