Eight workers were assigned to make Home contacts during this week; Six were assigned to direct personal calls, and two were assigned to generally advertise the activities. Between the dates of July 5 and July 29. 22 different home contact workers were employed. Between the dates mentioned, 861 personal calls were made by these workers from litsts submitted by school counselors and deans, and by Catholic Welfare workers. In additon, there has been a total of 1,942 general home calls made in which there was a total of 3,148 children contacts. These general home calls were for the purpose of advertising activities, and for inviting children to attend the playground and recreational activities.

Let me say we are happy to report that this project has meant a great deal to us in our summer program, and we believe our system of handling the project is sufficiently well organized to assure its complete success until the project is completed."
