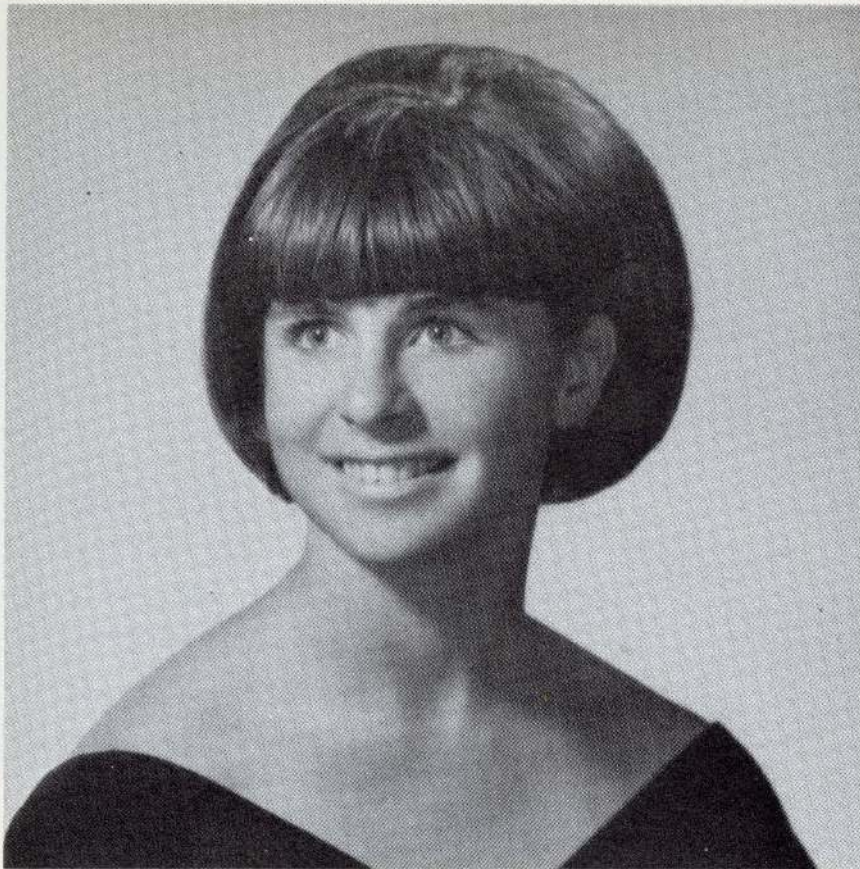
"Walk together, talk together, all ye people of the world. Then, and only then can ye have peace." These are the aims of the American Field Service Foreign Exchange Student Program.

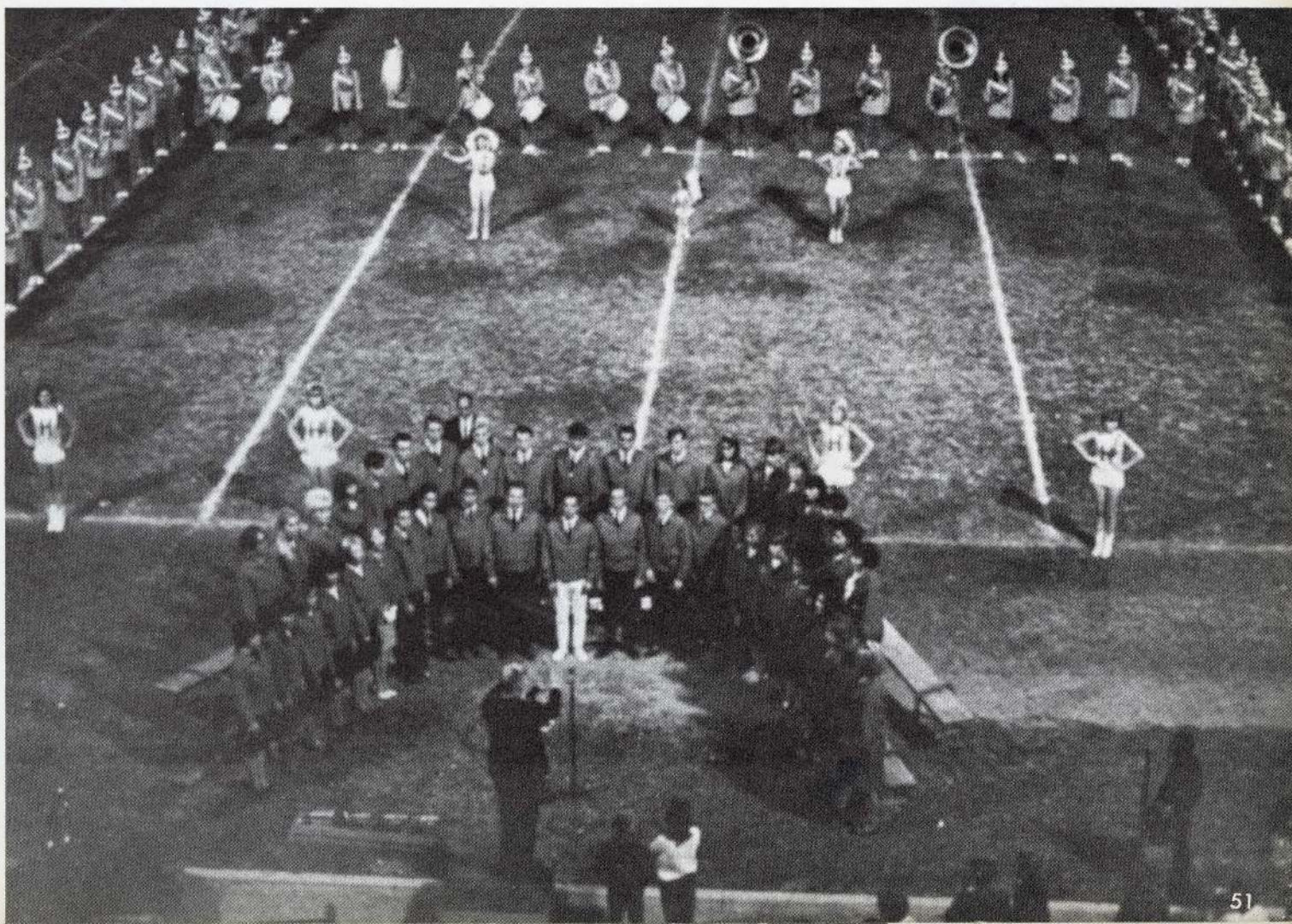
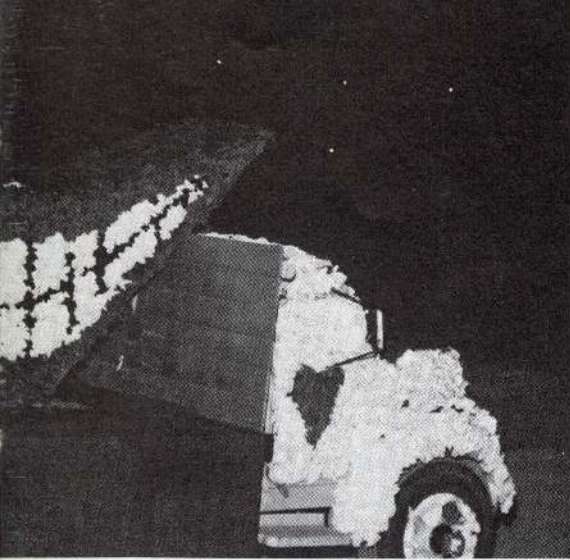


HOMECOMING FLOATS
