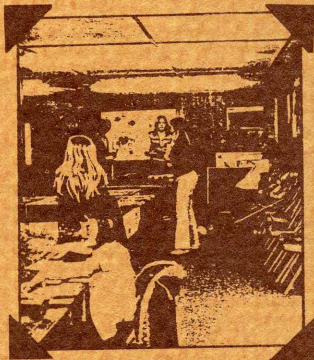

Trip programming provides an out-of-the-community recreational and cultural experience for the boys and girls.



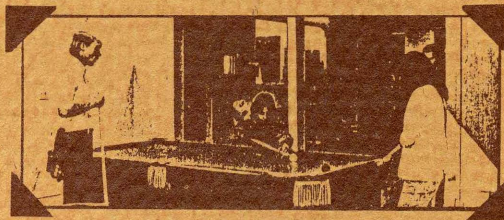

Sports programs are carried on between satellite clubs. The emphasis is on fun, not competition.



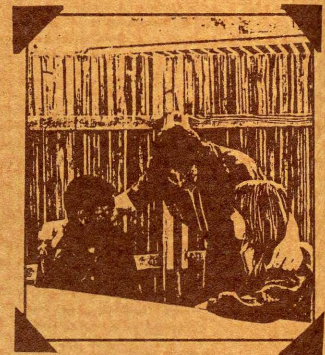

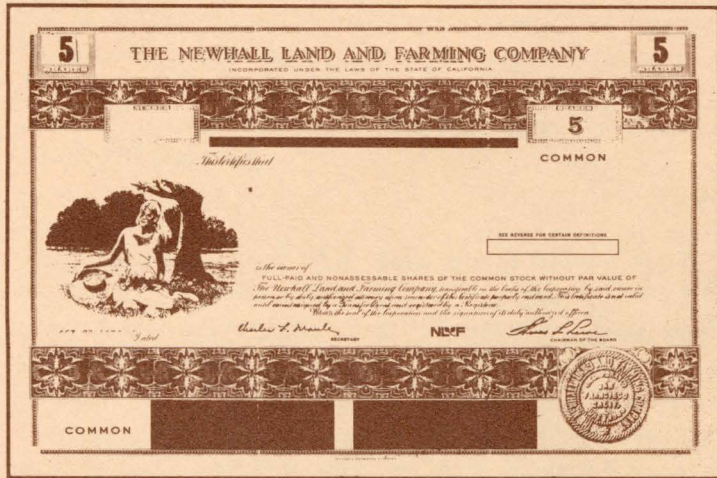
